Describing People: Appearances and Characteristics

Instructions:

- 1. Every student receives a piece of paper.
- 2. One student is selected to sit at the front of the room.
- 3. The student at the front must <u>describe</u> another student in the room OR a character <u>that is known by everyone</u>.
- 4. The students must <u>draw</u> the person being <u>described</u>.
- 5. When the description is finished, the student says who the person is and everyone shares drawings.

Character Examples:

- -Spiderman
- -Moana
- -Animals

Description Examples:

- -Boy or girl
- -Tall or short
- -Long hair or short hair
- -Clothing
- -Job
- -Family
- -Friends

Students who are drawing can ask questions about the student they are drawing.
