**breakfast** - *n.* the first meal of the day

**cabinet** - *n.* a piece of furniture that is used for storing things and usually has doors and shelves

**dry** - *adj.* having no or very little water or liquid

**flour** - *n.* powder made from a grain (especially wheat) that is used in cooking for making bread or cakes
