

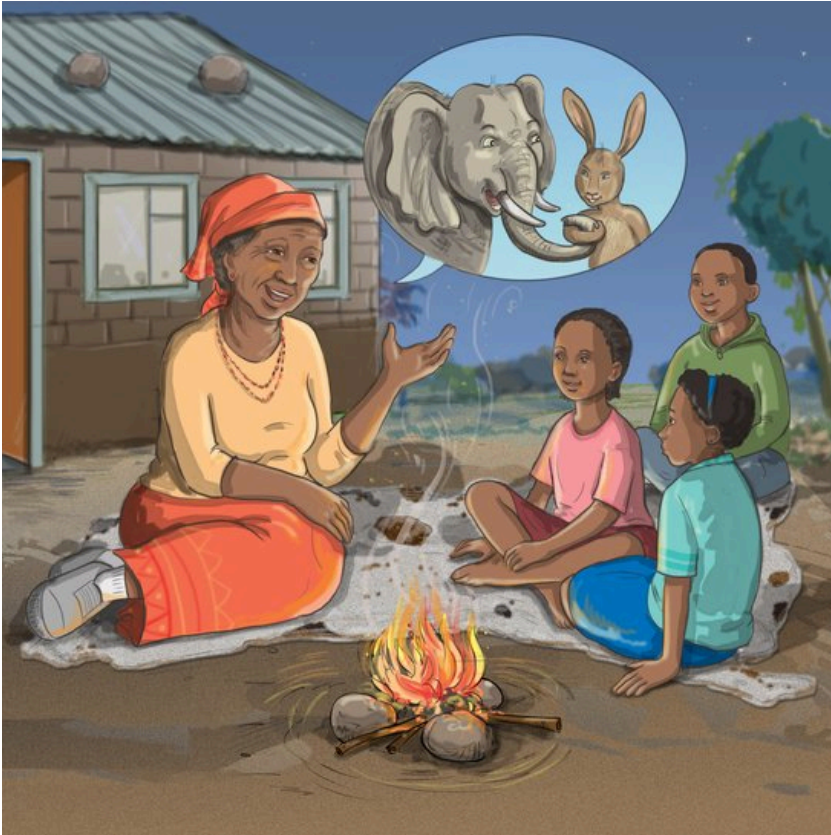

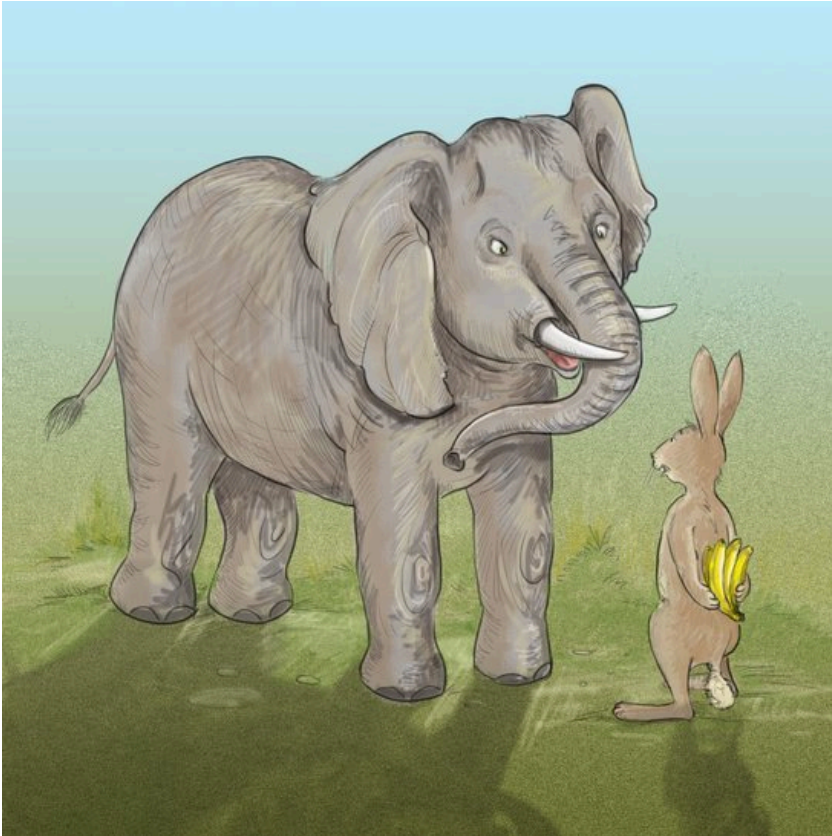

Elephant looked everywhere, but he did not find the thief.

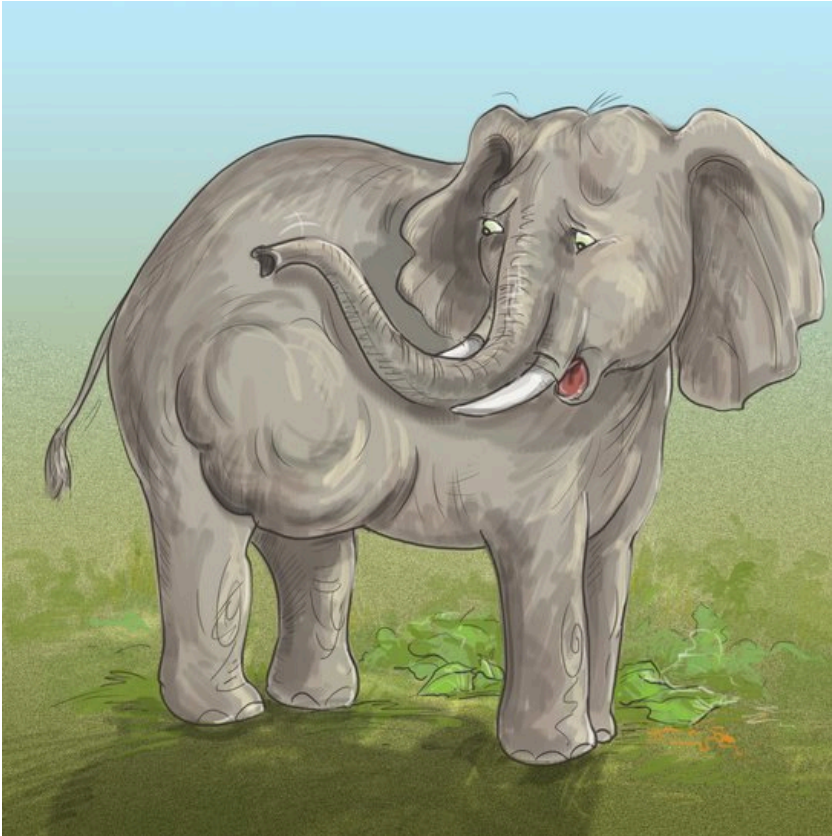




Another day, Hare escaped inside a big pumpkin.



Elephant saw the big pumpkin and swallowed it.

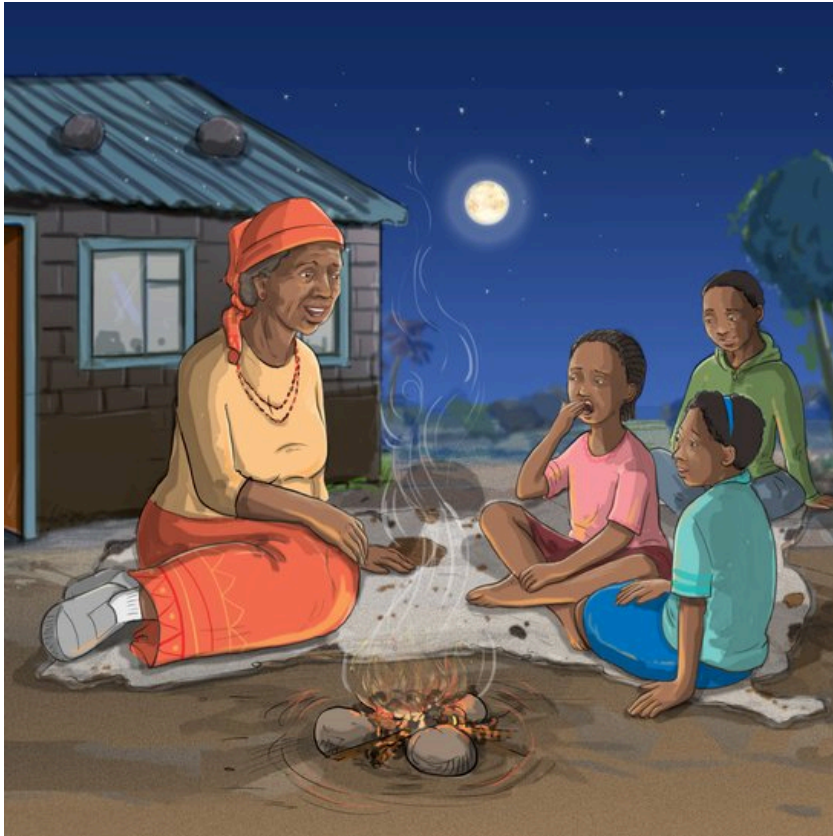


The pumpkin
