	Grammar: the indefinite article a/an: Indefinite articles do not refer to a specific object. It goes with a general noun A is used with consonants -A carrot/a tomato/a pineapple/ a mango An is used with vowels -an umbrella/an apple/an orange Similar to "one" or French "un/une" Indefinite articles are only used with SINGULAR nouns An apple/apples A litchi/litchis (Review singular vs. plural here if necessary) Indefinite articles cannot be used with count vs. noncount nouns Noncount: water, flour, money, time, meat, music, mataba
	Vocabulary: Fruit: apple, pineapple, mango, litchi, orange, soursop, lime Vegetables: carrot, tomato, onion, cassava, cucumber, tomato, pepper, potato, yam, lettuce Ask students for other categories
