	group must make three sentences – 1 simple present, simple past, present
	progressive. Have each group write their sentences on the board and discuss.
<u>Information</u>	
	Tell a story: Yesterday, I had a busy day. I had a lot of phone calls. Today, I have had a few. Yesterday, I cooked a lot of food. I have not cooked anything yet today.
	Introduce construction of present perfect: have/has + past participle.
	Explain uses:
	<u>Unfinished Time</u>
	Examples of finished time: last year, last week, yesterday, 2014, etc.
	Examples of unfinished time: today, this week, this month, this year, etc.
	Finished time uses simple past: Last week, I watched television two times.
	Unfinished time uses Present perfect: This week, I have watched television one
	time.
	Other examples:
	I visited my friends yesterday. Vs I have visited my friends today
	I saw three cats last week. Vs. This week, I have seen 3 cats
	last week, I went to Mutsamudu. Vs. This week, I have gone to Mutsamudu 3
	times.
	I brushed my teeth twice yesterday. Vs. I have brushed my teeth once today.
	Irregulars:
	To go – have gone
	To see – have seen
	To be – have been
	To eat – have eaten
	Past Experiences
	Past experiences are things you've done in the past and could do again.
	I have gone to Moroni.
	I have gone to Moroni 2 times.

	I have seen the movie 2 times.	
	I have traveled by airplane.	
	I have studied two languages.	
	I have talked to the President of Comoros.	
	Also include negatives!!
